### STRATEGY STATEMENT

Catch up funding has been allocated to a number of projects to:

1. Catch up on missed learning in English, Maths and French
2. Provide a remote learning system to enable students to catch up and keep up if isolating
3. Support students as they return to full time education from a pastoral perspective
4. Support staff during this transitional phase
5. Ensure that all students have access to ICT if isolating

Provide additional staffing for targeted support	A barrier to student progression is English and Maths attainment and we wish to support students to achieve a pass (4) in these subjects. There are large gaps from remote learning in French and we are addressing these gaps with bespoke intervention. Provide support for returning students	Additional staffing has been allocated to support students with any pastoral challenges that manifest themselves following lockdown and also in year.
